

## **Local report: 3 Renegades earn all-conference first team honors in football**

Freshman defensive end Keylon Hollis of Bakersfield College was a unanimous selection to the All-National Division Northern Conference football team voted on by conference coaches.

Hollis was one of three Renegades to earn first-team honors. The others were sophomore safety Tyler Dogins, who was also a first-team pick a year ago, and sophomore cornerback Taiyon Jackson.

No member of BC's team earned first-team honors on offense.

Two Renegades, sophomore wide receiver Brandon Hobdy and freshman running back Jalen Sykes, earned 2nd-team honors.

Second-team selections were sophomore tackle Tevin Jackson and sophomore linebacker Ian Driskill. Jackson was second-team last year, too.

Hollis, from Cypress Creek High School in Houston, had a conference-leading 12.5 sacks and led BC with 17 tackles for losses.

Dogins, a Ridgeview High School graduate, had four interceptions and five pass break-ups. He returned two of the interceptions for touchdowns and ranked third on BC with 73 overall tackles and third with 45 solo tackles.

Taiyon Jackson, a West High School graduate, moved to cornerback from wide receiver last summer. He had two interceptions, eight pass break-ups and ranked second on BC with 50 solo tackles and fourth with 70 overall tackles.

Cerritos went 5-0 to win the conference. Cerritos' Frank Mazotta was Coach of the Year and his quarterback, Brandon Denker was Offensive Player of the Year.

El Camino lineman Jordan Tavai was Defensive Player of the Year.

BC went 4-6 and tied Canyons for fifth place in the six-team NNC at 1-4.

CSUB wrestling

CSU Bakersfield's wrestling team will play host to 20th-ranked Cal Poly tonight at 7 in the Icardo Center.

CSUB's 125-pound Tyler Iwamura (7-0) is ranked No. 20 by [wrestlingreport.com](http://wrestlingreport.com). Cal Poly has four ranked wrestlers, led by No. 2 Boris Novachkov at 141 pounds. Novachkov was the runner-up last year at the NCAA Championships.

Former Bakersfield High standouts Anthony Box of CSUB and Travis Rasmussen of Cal Poly are scheduled to meet each other in the 157-pound match.
